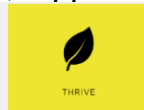
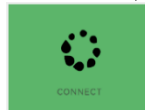
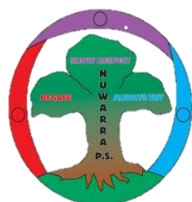


The Values program is a resource that provides Nuwarra Public School a means to teach and support student understanding of the values that help shape attitudes and strategies. Nuwarra Public School has 10 core values which contribute to individuals participating in activities and making decisions. The purpose of this handbook is to provide an understanding of what Nuwarra's Values are, how it applies to the Nuwarra Public School context, and the method of implementation across the whole school.

The primary goal of the Values program is to provide students with support and strategies to recognise and achieve positive attitude and behaviour towards learning and social interactions. The lessons have interactive activities to help students consolidate their understanding, and allow for staff and students to revisit specific values.

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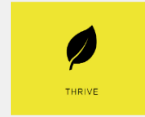
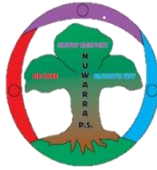


The Values program provides an explicit approach to teaching the students the core values of Nuwarra Public School. These lessons are provided by a PowerPoint, with two slides for each Value. The first slide will give a definition to the Value, how to display that value through the School Expectations and allow your class to discuss what the value looks like, sounds like and feels like.

Value definition → **Resilience**

What is resilience?
Resilience is when someone can pick themselves back up after a hard or sad time. A person who is resilient can cope with difficult tasks or when something doesn't go their way.



- Be Safe**

- Show Respect**
Speaking politely to students who have won a game, accepting defeat.
- Always Try**

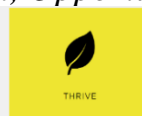
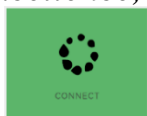
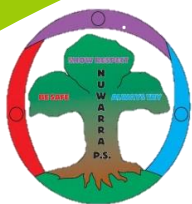
